

96FM FUGITIVE FOUND IN GLANMIRE AFTER 9 YEARS

A man has been found to have been living in the wilderness of Glanmire for the past 9 years. Darragh Keogh, originally came to the area as part of a radio competition run by Cork's 96 FM.

The competition was a sort of interactive game of manhunt in which listeners would listen for clues as to the whereabouts of the fugitive, before approaching them and asking "are you the 96FM fugitive"?

However he was never successfully found by any members of the public. His intense


dedication to the role of the 96FM Fugitive caused Darragh to completely lose his grip on reality.

A search party had begun soon after his disappearance, but was quickly called off when it could not be confirmed which suburb of the city he had gone to seek refuge in.

His home since 2011 has been the wooded area at the back of John O'Callaghan Park. He was found this week in a gaunt yet relatively healthy condition. He has been taken into care at Cork's University Hospital for tests.

It has not been confirmed if any of the Gardai or Hospital staff that have been in contact with Mr. Keogh have attempted to claim the €30,000 prize. It is thought that if a person were to ask him if he is the 96FM fugitive in his current fragile mental state, he may flee into the wild once again.

The radio station has so far refused to comment on the story.

Struck Off! with Dr. Niamh Nic Gearailt

(DANDRUFF)

Dandruff is a common condition that causes the skin on the scalp to flake. It isn't contagious or serious. But it can be embarrassing and difficult to treat. The bald can also suffer from dandruff, it is rare, but can occur and is a bewildering sight, akin to a well floured counter-top.

Mild dandruff can be treated with a gentle daily shampoo. If that

doesn't work, try a more vigorous head massaging technique. Ideally, you will hear the scrape of your fingernails on your skull. If that doesn't work, try a medicated shampoo, but to be honest this is extreme territory. The medicated stuff doesn't mess around. There is a real risk of chemical burning of the scalp and fingers.

Dandruff is generally considered to be a mild form of seborrheic dermatitis, which itself is medical jargon for dandruff. In babies, seborrheic dermatitis is called cradle cap.

Dandruff signs and symptoms may include:

- •Skin flakes on your scalp, hair, eyebrows, shoulders, beard or mustache (if applicable), arm-pit, chest and belly hair, and finally the dreaded pubis.
- Itchy scalp
- Constantly scanning rooms for items that could double as a scratching device
- Scaly, crusty scalp in infants with cradle cap
- •The signs and symptoms may be more severe if you're stressed, and they tend to flare in cold, dry seasons. In parts of the Arctic, dandruff can be seen simply floating from the heads of those who suffer from it, like dandelion spores.

So, the real question, when to see a doctor?

Most cases of dandruff don't require a doctor's care, in fact, even if you think it does, you are not a qualified professional, you are probably misdiagnosing yourself, and ultimately wasting your time and more importantly, mine.

If you absolutely must, see your primary care doctor or a doctor who specializes in skin conditions (dermatologist, a.k.a quack).





The founder member of Glanmire Community Responder Group says that he is "shocked" and "fucking gutted" that one of the group's defibrillators was damaged last weekend.

The heated cabinet holding the potentially life saving piece of equipment, which is located on Barnavara Hill, was broken sometime between Friday evening and Monday last. In addition to the cabinet being damaged, there are urine stains also on the defibrillator and the surrounding area. Speaking to the Glanmire News Area this week, Iain Geary said that it will cost around €700 to replace the cabinet and a further €7 to deal with the smell. The defibrillator is being tested this week. If it needs to be replaced it will cost up to €2,000.

Mr Geary said that he and his fellow first responders were all "fucking gutted" and "shocked" to hear that vandals had targeted the defibrillator.

The chances of someone surviving after suffering a cardiac arrest increase a fair amount if a defibrillator is used to treat them while waiting for medical attention to arrive. Mr Geary says that the voluntary group, which has 2 defibrillators located around the town, has not yet saved the lives of any local people in the last 12 months, but that that wasn't the point.

"We never thought this would happen. The people of Glanmire

are disgusted," he said, speaking for thousands of people.

There is "great community spirit" in Glanmire and "local people, with three notable exceptions, have been very supportive of the group since it was formed in 2020", Mr Geary added.


At the moment Glanmire Community Responder Group has 5 members, down from 8 last month as three members have had their membership suddenly revoked. "They have also been banished from the WhatsApp group", Mr Geary confirmed, with a disdain not witnessed before by this reporter in any man or beast.



You can borrow eBooks, eMagazines, pick up some ePamphlets, take online courses, learn a language or stream a documentary film.





BOOK OF THE Month


